

PEOPLE'S COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

The Award

The purpose of People's College Scholarship is to support first-time college students with their career path by offering a monetary incentive to cover qualified college expenses such as Partial Tuition, School Books, School Equipment and Relocation Expenses. The People's Memorial College Scholarship awards two prizes of \$1,000. This scholarship application is open to LES People's FCU members and non-members.

Eligibility – The applicant:

- Must be a college-bound high school senior at the time of the application,
- Must be attending college for the first time on the fall of 2023,
- Must be enrolled in either a two- or four-year accredited educational institution,
- Must agree to use the awarded funds for qualified expenses before January 31, 2024.

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	Complete the Scholarship application. The applicant can submit only one application. The completed application must be submitted with:
	a high school transcript documenting student's GPA for grades 9–11;
	I a typed essay response; and
	an SAT/PSAT/ACT transcript (if applicable)
Auth	The applicant and his/her parent or guardian must sign the Certification and Release norization on the last page of the application form. The application, transcripts and essay must be submitted to the credit union by Friday,
Mar	ch 31, 2023 at 4pm. If any portion is incomplete or missing, the application will not be idered.

Selection Process

Judging will be based on both subjective criteria and weighted, objective criteria. These include essay, academic achievements, extracurricular and community activities, etc.

Receiving Award

Awards will be deposited into the winners' accounts at LES People's FCU. Awards ceremony will take place at the 2023 LES People's FCU Annual Meeting in the spring. Winners are expected to attend.

Application Deadline

Applications must be sent or drop off at any LES People's branch no later than **March 31**, **2023**, at **4pm**. Completed applications can also be submitted via email to connect@lespfcu.org with subject line SCHOLARSHIP 2022.
